**Three Injured In Mishap; 1 Driver Held**

Three men, Rex Duvall and Lewis Fouts, of the burning-corn community, and James W. Oakes, of Knoxville, Tenn., were injured in the head-on collision of two automobiles on the Franklin-Clayton highway last Wednesday afternoon. Both cars were virtually demolished.

T. W. Smith, of Knoxville driver of one of the automobiles, was charged with reckless driving and was released Thursday on a \$200 cash bond.

The three injured were admitted to Angel hospital for treatment of severe bruises and lacerations. Mr. Duvall and Mr. Fouts were discharged Thursday, and Mr. Oakes Friday.

Riding with Mr. Smith in a 1946 Chevrolet sedan, which was traveling north, were Edward Payne, Bob Houser, and Oakes, and James Phillips, all of Knoxville. The only occupants of the other car, a 1934 Ford coach, were Mr. Duvall and Mr. Fouts.

The accident occurred when the car driven by Mr. Smith attempted to round the Lowry curve, traveling north at what officers said was a high rate of speed; ran off the pavement on the left hand side, cut back on to the pavement and crashed into the car driven by Duvall, going south, before returning to the right side of the road. Tire marks clearly showed the course of travel taken by the Smith car.

Although broken beer bottles were found in the Ford, all occupants of both cars were examined and no one was found to have been drinking according to Deputy Sheriff Walter Dean, who assisted Sheriff J. P. Bradley in investigating the accident.

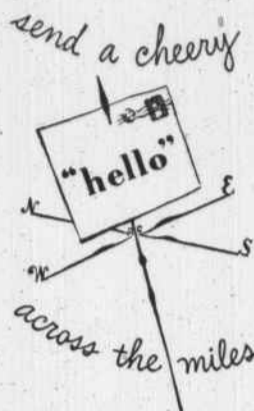

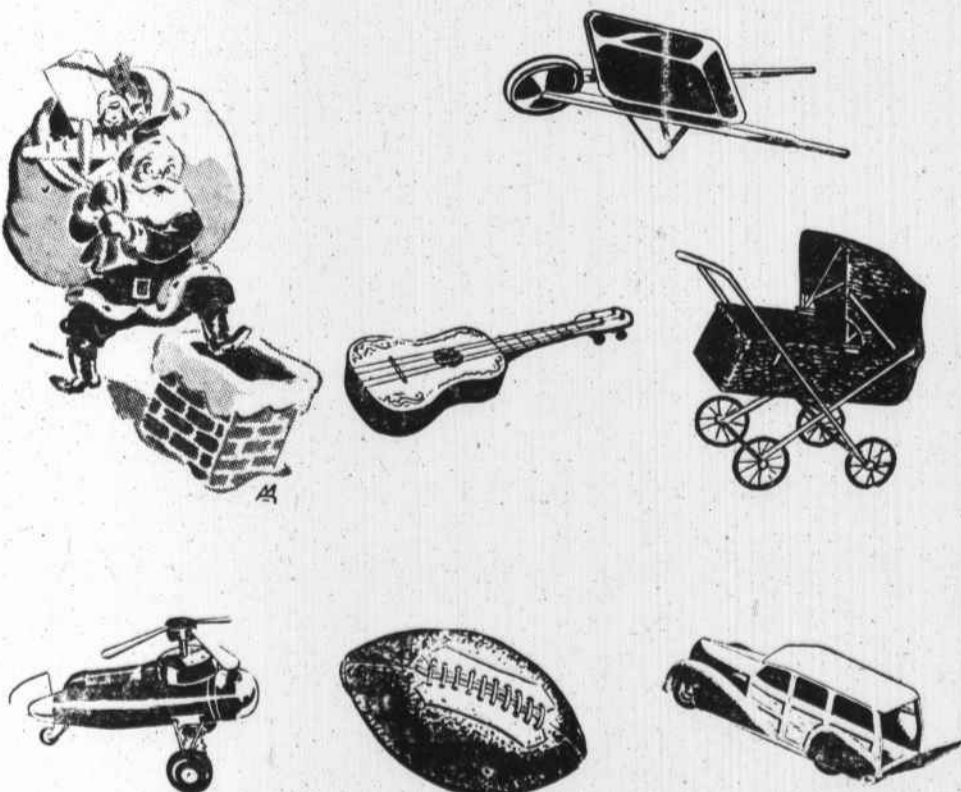
