New Franklin-Asheville Bus Schedule In Effect

The Smoky Mountain Trailways has added an additional schedule to its Franklin-Asheville service, providing through service via Sylva. The new bus leaves Franklin at 7 a. m. and reaches Asheville at 9:50. The same bus, on the return trip, leaves Asheville at 1 p. m. and arrives in Franklin at 3:50 p. m., making the trip via Sylva without change.

Limited Access

Highways Reduce Mishaps, Official Says

Motor vehicle accident records prove conclusively that the limited access highway can materially reduce casualties on the nation's roads, J. T. Callaway, president of the American Road Builders' association, has pointed out.

"Traffic casualties for the first six months of 1947 totaled 14,480, as compared with 15,890 at the same point last year. But since May, each month has shown a rise of five to eight per cent over the corresponding month last year," Mr. Callaway said.

"With 37,000,000 vehicles on the highways—more than ever before in history—we are faced with a constantly increasing problem of accident prevention. The rapid modernization of heavily traveled roads becomes a necessity. Our highways are not equipped to meet the demands of present day traffic.

"New highways are making a definite contribution to the safety of the motorist," Mr. Callaway said. He cited a report from the California state highway department showing that accidents on one of the most heavily traveled routes in the state, Highway 89, between Colton and Ontario, have been cut 50 per cent by the construction of a new limited access highway. The 50 per cent holds despite the fact that traffic on the route is heavier this year than last.

Limited access design virtually eliminates the pedestrian accident, and two-car collisions are prevented by divided highway design, Mr. Callaway explained.

More than 50 major railroads are making arrangements with banks for "travel loans", based on earning power and the applicant's character, to be repaid within a year. No security, no down payment required.
