NEW BOOKMOBILE ON ROAD—Above is shown the new bookmobile of the Fontana Regional Library, which was put in operation Tuesday. It serves Macon, Swain and Jackson counties. A 1947 half-ton Chevrolet, dark green with white lettering, it is the first of 44 new bookmobiles to be bought by North Carolina libraries. Books, magazines, and pamphlets are carried by the bookmobile to homes, stores, post offices, and schools in the rural areas of the three counties, with stops made once every five weeks. The bookmobile, which holds approximately 1,000 volumes, has a magazine rack, a bulletin board; and both inside and outside shelving. North Carolina has more bookmobiles in operation than any other state in the Union.
