Auto Inspection Law

(This is one of a series of the motoring public with articles designed to acquaint the requirements of the Motor Vehicle Inspection program).

RALEIGH.—Motorist, did you ever give any thought to whether or not the steering alignment or assembly of your car or truck is in good safe condi-

If not, now's the time to think about it, for when your car enters one of the Motor Vehicle department's 40 inspec-tion lanes, it may be condemned if its steering equipment does not come up to the minimum

### Only 12 Counties Have Fewer Traffic Deaths Than Macen

Only 12 North Carolina

counties had fewer persons killed in traffic accidents last year than Macon, figures compiled by the state Department of Motor Vehicles reveal.

Two persons were killed in automobile accidents in this county in 1947. Eight counties — Bruns-

Your nearest garage or repair shop will likely give you a free inspection, and tell you if your car is in safe condition. Many shops have Minimum requirements?
