

# Peddling Now Forbidden On Streets Here

Peddling on the streets of Franklin, except for Macon County farmers selling their own produce, is prohibited by an ordinance adopted last week by the board of aldermen, and which is now in effect.

While excepting Macon County farmers from its general provisions, it sets one hour as the downtown parking limit for farmers' trucks selling produce.

The text of the ordinance follows:

It shall be unlawful for any person, firm or corporation to peddle, sell or offer to sell, from trucks, wagons, or any other vehicles, or in any manner or place, except in a regular established place of business, any fruit, vegetables, products, livestock, meats, or merchandise on any of the streets in the Town of Franklin.

"This ordinance shall not apply to Macon County farmers

who grow and offer to sell their own vegetables, fruit, livestock or meats, but it shall be unlawful for them to park on Main street from the post office to Kelly's Tea room, or on Phillips street from its intersection with Main street to its intersection with Palmer street, or on Lotia street from its intersection with Main street to its intersection with Church street, or on the Public square including the area on both the east and west sides of the courthouse for more than one hour.

"Any person, firm or corporation violating any provision of this ordinance shall be guilty of a misdemeanor and upon conviction shall be fined \$10 for the first offense and \$25 for each offense thereafter, or be imprisoned in the county jail for not more than thirty days."
