Court's School Ruling To Have No Effect Here

The recent decision of the U.S. Supreme Court, barring religious teaching in the public schools, will have no effect in Macon County, in the opinion of Guy L. Houk, county superintendent.

Macon County schools hold chapel services, at which the Bible is read, Mr. Houk said, but he added that he does not believe the court's decision applies to such services.
