## Health Nurse To Visit Five Schools Here

Mrs. Frank Shope, who Monday assumed her duties as Macon County public health nurse, has announced that she will visit five schools during the next week.

At each school all first graders will be inspected, and Mrs. Shope will give typhoid immunizations. These immunizations will be available to adults, as well as school children, she pointed out.

The nurse will visit Oak Dale and Burningtown schools tomorrow (Friday). Next Wednesday she will be at Iotla. And on Thursday, April 22, she will visit the Otter Creek and Kyle schools.

Mrs. Shope will be in the public health office in the Asher building on Mondays and Saturday mornings, and she announced that Dr. Mary B. H. Michal, district health officer, will be at the health office here each Monday afternoon from 1 to 3:30 o'clock.

In commenting on the typhoid immunizations, Mrs. Shope remarked that it is recognized that either a series of three doses of typhoid vaccine should be given every three years, or one dose each year, to keep the individual immunized, and that the yearly dose is advised.

Any parents who do not wish their children immunized are asked to send a note to the children's teacher at the school
