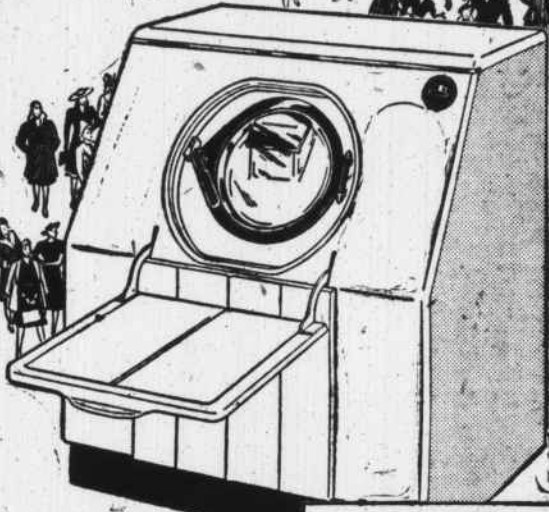

MY POSITION ON SCHOOL ISSUES

BEING a member of the County Board of Education is a job that no one wants for a financial reason, as I understand there is almost no pay in the position.

I filed my name as a candidate for the Democratic nomination for the reason that I am very much interested in the schools of this county, and believe there are a great many improvements that should be made in our schools. My interest is both as a citizen and as the father of a child attending one of the Macon County schools.

I live in Highlands and do not know a great many of the voters in other townships, and they do not know me or the things I stand for, and therefore I believe it my duty to state the position I will take upon several vital matters in our educational system, if elected.
