Extension Work In N. C. **Is Reorganized** 

The forestry extension pro-gram in North Carolina has been reorganized and a specialist has been assigned the five extension districts of the state, according to a in W. Graeber, in charge of forestry extension at State college John E. Ford, Asheville, is the Western district speciausi The staff also includes John L

Gray, assistant extension forester, at State college. Mr. Graeber said these men

are now setting up their head-quarters. They have been instructed to visit all the counties of their respective districts a rapidly as possible, to meet the farm agents and to discuss plans for an intensified program of forestry extension. This program, Mr. Graeber stated, will be built on an educational and demonstrational basis.

The educational program will include such activities as timber thinning and stand improvement, selective harvesting, pruning, management plans on demonstration farms. timber scaling, forest planting for both timber and erosion control, marketing, 4-H club and other types of contests, tours, and
