3-Pcint Program Adopted To Keep Area Free From Disease

A three-point program has been adopted by Highianus to protect its citizens and summer visitors", it has been announced. There has been no polio in Highlands and vicinity this year, and authorities explained they are seeking to prevent any cases.

The three points in the pro-

1. All children under 16 years of age arriving in Highlands from polio epidemic areas will be quarantined for two weeks, and hotels are requested not to provide accommodations for such such persons.

2. Garbage is being picked up daily, and residents and business establishments are being required to place their garbage in closed containers.

3. The town dump and garbage trucks are being sprayed with DDT.

The program was adopted last Thursday night at a joint meeting of the town board, directors of the chamber of commerce, medical authorities; and a special committee of business men. Members of the latter group are Charles Anderson, O. F. Summer, and William (Bill) Way.

Electric Pumps In Rural School Wells Favored By Fricks

An unusual feature for a grand jury report was the rec-ommendation made recently by the Transylvania county grand jury that electric water pumps be installed in the wells of all that county's rural schools, with view to providing more samtary water systems.

The report has a special interest for Macon County, since the grand jury foreman was Vernon H. Fricks, a former restuent of this county.

The grand jury visited every school in Transylvania, the re-port explained. Out of those visits, came the recommendation for electric water pumps in the wells of rural schools. The report also suggested that school buses should be equipped with heaters and that booths be erected to house children waning for buses.


