

Will Select Macon AAA Committees

Macon County farmers next Thursday will elect community and county committees to serve in the 1949 AAA program, it was announced this week by the local AAA office.

Each of the 11 communities into which the county is divided by the AAA will elect a committee of five. In addition, each community will elect one county delegate.

These 11 county delegates will meet in Franklin the following day (Friday, December 3) to choose a county AAA committee of three members, with two ad-

ditional persons chosen as alternate members of the county committee.

All farmers in the county who have participated in the 1948 AAA program are eligible to vote.

Through this committee method, the AAA office here pointed out, the farmers help to direct the AAA programs that are designed to conserve the soil and increase its fertility.

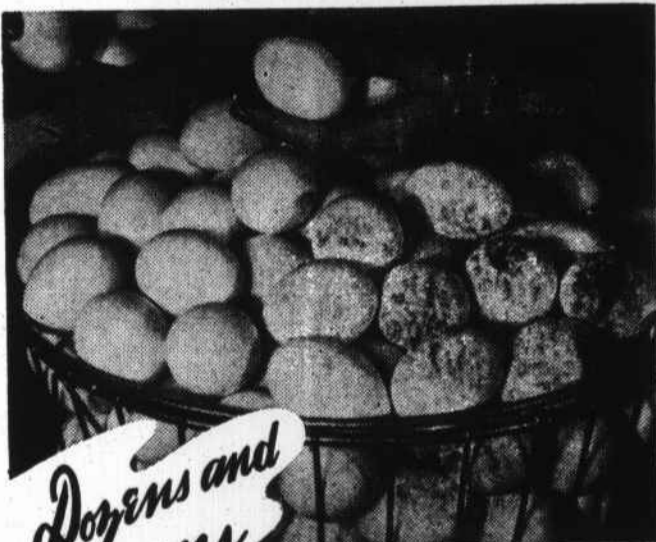
