Now Is Time To Make Barn Safer Place

As winter approaches and the pressure of field work subsides, barns become the principal work center for daily farm chores.

The State college extension service has a suggestion to help take the aches and pains out of those routine chores. The advice is: "Take time to look for

ways to make those chores safe and easy."

Unfortunately, many hazards and inconveniences have been built into barns and feed lots. It was pointed out. These have been neglected or remained unnoticed for years. Now is the time to correct them.

Here are some recommendations prepared by the National Safety Council:

1. **Clearing and set things in order** if the aisles, ways or work areas are cluttered with feed, tools, harness, feed carts or other obstacles. Avoid storing loose material on the floor, and see that dangerous corners and ends of beams are adequately lighted. Also check your barn for other hazards that cause fall. High door sills, abrupt changes in floor levels, weak boards, protruding nails, tripping hazards, all will be removed. All floors should be solid, smooth and continuous.

2. **Feed chutes and ladders** are accident areas in most barns. A well-constructed stairway that is hand-railed and kept clean provides the safest and easiest passage to feeders. It is dangerous to use stairwells as feed chutes because hay or straw may be falling. Separate feed chutes that are guarded above the 1st floor are desirable. When it is necessary to use a ladder, see that it extends well above the 1st floor. It should also have well-spaced stout rungs that are placed far enough from the wall for secure footing.

Plans Laid

For 1948 Farm and Home Week Program

Plans for an outstanding North Carolina Farm and Home Week program for 1948 were made by State College officials and agricultural leaders of the state in a recent meeting at the college.

Date for the event was set as the second week in August, which is about two weeks earlier than usual. Beginning on Monday, August 8, and continuing through Thursday evening, August 11, the program will include general sessions and subject matter discussions each morning; tours, demonstrations, and visits to exhibits each afternoon; and addresses and recreational features each evening.

On Thursday evening the principal feature will be an educational program on farm and home mechanization, during which several thousand dollars worth of prizes will be awarded. An effort will be made to have this program handled by personnel of a well-known national radio quiz show and possibly have it broadcast on a coast-to-coast hookup.

Farm and Home Week was not held in 1943 because of the polio epidemic. The event normally attracts more than 5,000 farmers and homemakers from all parts of the State.

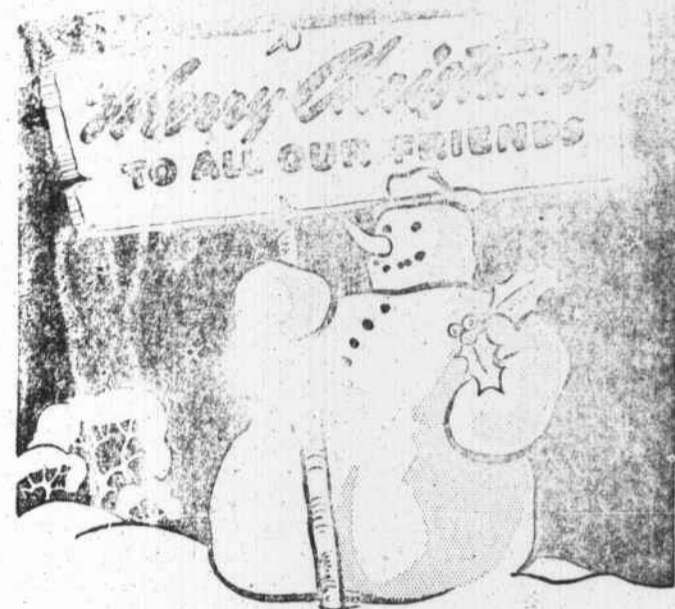
