Senators Say They Also Oppose Ambassador To Vatican

North Carolina's two senators, Clyde R. Hoey and Willis Smith,

Senator Hoey's reply said, "... I appreciate the opposi-

tion of your association to this appointment and wish to advise that I am also against this appointment and shall do what I can to defeat the confirmation of the appointee. . . ."

"... I am thoroughly opposed to the violation of our constitutional principle of the separation of church and state", Senator Smith wrote. "I have great respect for every man's church, but I wish to see every church treated as a church and not as a state. Otherwise, we will have the same problems that the history of many other nations has recorded. . . ."
