

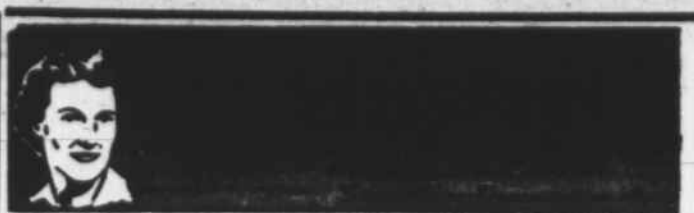
**APPROVE BULL BUY**

The Macon County Cooperative Breeders Association, Inc., has announced its approval of the purchase of Donna Dandy Sultan, R. J. 490287, by the American Breeders Service, for

use in artificial insemination service rendered local dairymen by their organization. The bull, which is classified "very good", was listed in the February 25 Jersey Bulletin as a superior sire with 10 tested daughters

averaging 9,966 pounds of milk, 5.1 per cent test, and 506 pounds of butter fat and 11 classified daughters who averaged 85.88 per cent.

**State College Answers Timely Farm Questions**

Q. Are litter materials necessary on poultry house floors?

A. Yes, says R. S. Dearstynne, head of the department of poultry science, State College. In choosing a litter, try to avoid damp, wet, or excessively dusty materials. Some popular litter materials are sand, sawdust, straw, pine needles, crushed corn cob, peanut hulls, chopped corn stalk, and a number of commercial products.

Q. What damage can we expect from the 17-year-locust that is supposed to appear in the western part of the state this year?

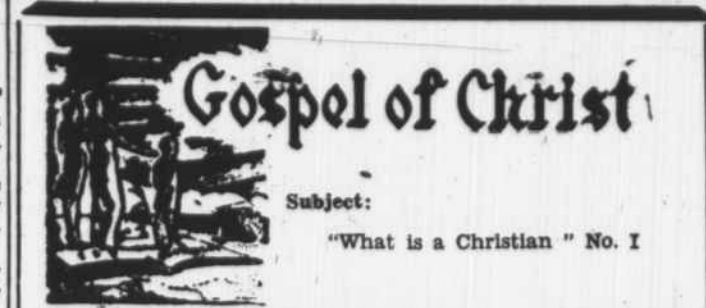
A. Unfortunately, says Z. P. Metcalf, professor of entomology and zoology at State College, what is commonly known as the 17-year-locust will do some damage in orchards. Actually it is not the locust referred to in Biblical stories, but a cicada.

"The only real damage will be to young apple orchards in newly-cleared ground."

**Gospel of Christ**

Subject: "What is a Christian" No. 1

**ATTITUDE OF MANY CONCERNING THE NAME:** Not infrequently people who, as individuals, wear religious names not found in the Bible, will, when brought face to face with that fact, ask somewhat scornfully, "What's in a name?" Yet they will work hard to provide for their families and to meet their obligations promptly and will treat their neighbors with kindness and consideration. Why? Because they wish to maintain a good name, and any adverse reflection thereon, they will resent — and rightly so! Notwithstanding, when it is pointed out they are wearing a name religiously unheard of in the Word of God, they ask, "What's in a name?" Their very life shows the inconsistency of their question.

**GOD'S ATTITUDE TOWARD NAMES:** God changed Abram's name, which means a "high father", to Abraham, which means "father of a multitude"; and for this reason: "Neither shall thy name any more be called Abram, but thy name shall be Abraham; for a father of many nations have I made thee," Gen. 17:5. In Gen. 32:28 we find the angel saying, "Thy name shall be called no more Jacob, but Israel: for as a prince hast thou power with God and with men, and hast prevailed." The name Jacob means "supplanter." He had supplanted Esau, but the name Israel means "the prince that prevails with God." Thus, we understand the meaning of names. Furthermore, God named John before his birth. "But the angel said unto him, Fear not, Zacharias: for thy prayer is heard; and thy wife Elizabeth shall bear thee a son, and thou shalt call his name John." Luke 1:13. Jesus was likewise named of God before his birth. "And, behold, thou shalt conceive in thy womb, and bring forth a son, and shalt call his name Jesus." Luke 1:31. In view of the foregoing, we must conclude that, though names in the Bible may not mean much to some religionists, those names obviously mean a very great deal to God.

**ORIGIN OF THE NAME CHRISTIAN:** In Isaiah 56:5 "Even unto them will I give in mine house and within my walls a PLACE and a NAME better than of sons and of daughters: I will give them an everlasting NAME, that shall not be cut off." To what does the Lord God refer, when He states within my house and within my walls? Let the Scriptures interpret the Scriptures. Turn, now, and read I Tim. 3:14,15; "These things write I unto thee, hoping to come unto thee shortly; but if I tarry long, that thou mayest know how thou oughtest to behave thyself in the HOUSE OF GOD WHICH IS THE CHURCH OF THE LIVING GOD, the pillar and ground of the truth." Therefore, the name prophesied in Isa 56:5 was to be given to those in the church. Let us read now from Isa. 62—"And the Gentiles shall see thy righteousness, and all kings thy glory: and THOU SHALT BE CALLED BY A NAME, WHICH THE MOUTH OF THE LORD SHALL NAME." Hence, we learn that God would do the naming. Concerning the kings seeing "thy glory" we read in Acts 4:26, "The kings of the earth stood up, and the rulers were gathered together against the Lord, and against his Christ." And as regards the Gentiles seeing "thy glory," Cornelius and his household became the first Gentile converts as set forth in Acts 10. In the next chapter, Acts 11:26, we find this reading, "And when he (Barnabas) had found him (Saul), he brought him unto Antioch. And it came to pass, that a whole year they assembled themselves with the church, and taught much people. AND THE DISCIPLES WERE CALLED CHRISTIANS FIRST AT ANTIOCH." Therefore, the God-given name is simply Christian. Not this kind or that kind of a Christian, but simply-Christian.

It is our plea that people will renounce all human names, names not applied to God's people, in the Bible, and accept those that are therein found. Here is grounds on which all of us can be united.
