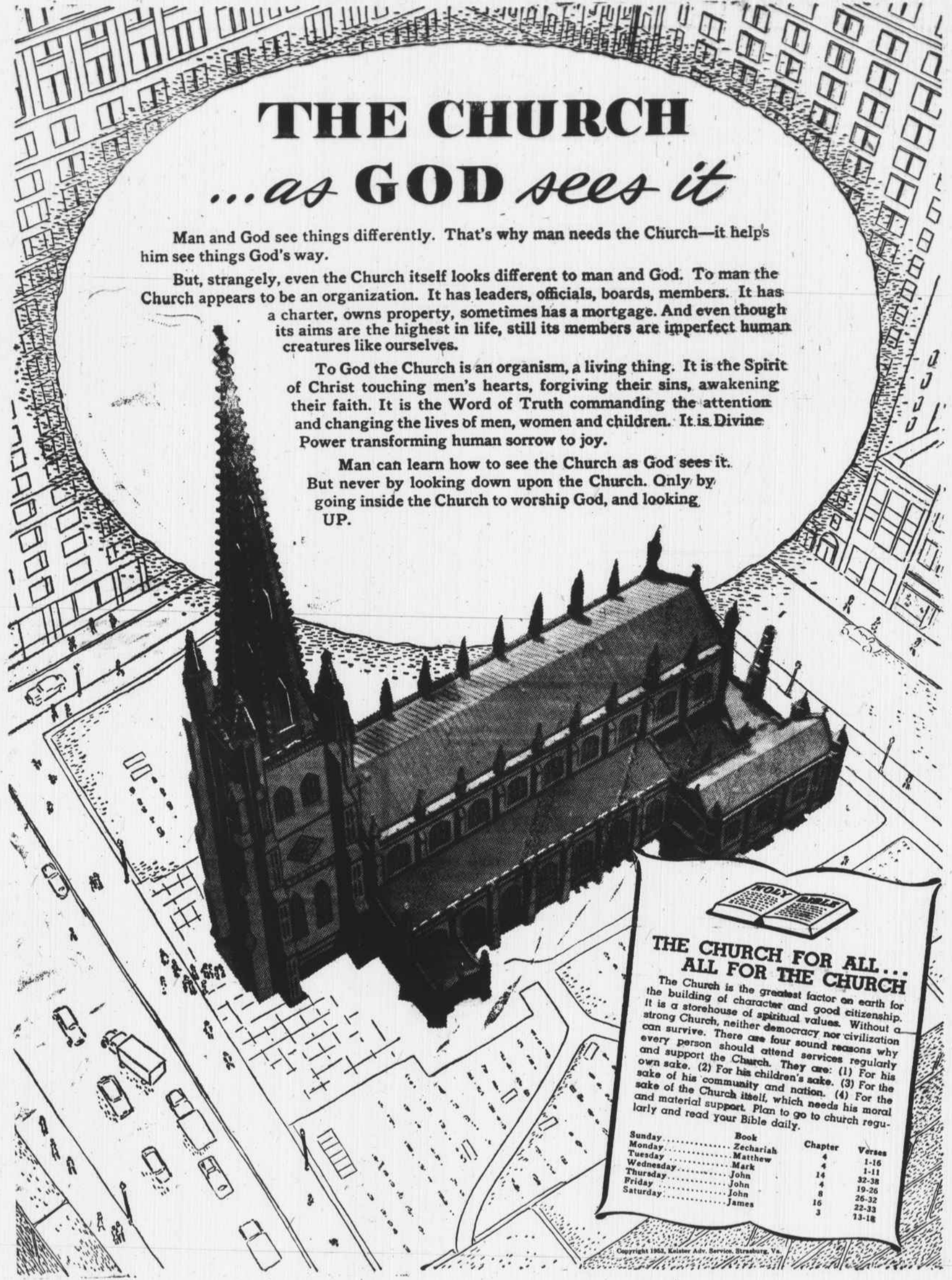
THE CHURCH ...as GOD sees it
