DEATH TAKES C. S. LOVE

Negro Native Dies Tuesday At Franklin Home At Age Of 85

A farmer, he was a member of the Bethlehem Baptist Church, where funeral services were conducted the following afternoon at 2 o'clock by the Rev. J. H. Smith. Burial was in the Love cemetery. 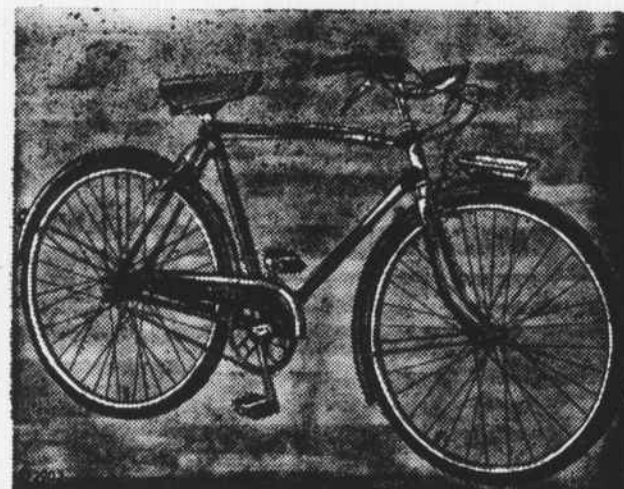

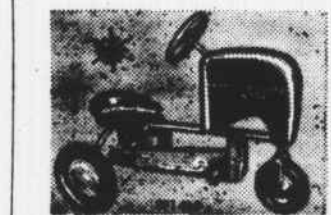

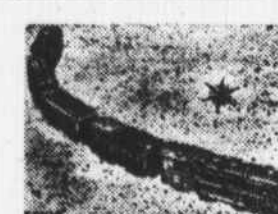
