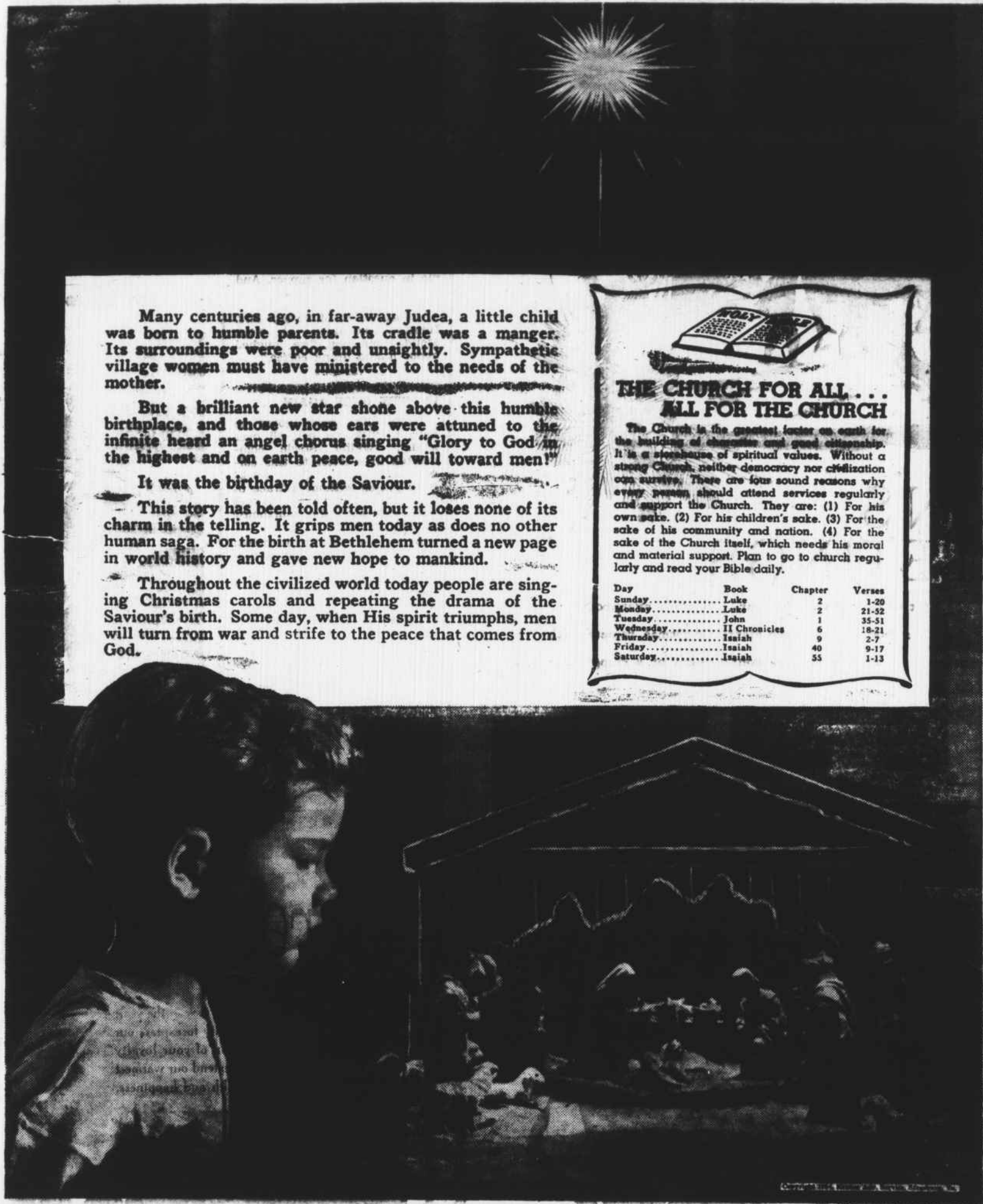


Services Of Macon County Churches
