

Dun And Bradstreet Sends 150 Requests To County

More than 150 Macon County businessmen this month are receiving requests from Dun and Bradstreet for annual financial statements for 1956 listings.

In the current issue ('55) of the Dun and Bradstreet reference book are listed 175 local manufacturers, wholesalers, and retailers — an increase of two per cent over 1954, according to a release from the firm.

During '56, Dun and Brad-

street estimates it will be required to make about 100 changes in the listings of business enterprises here. These changes, it is explained, will result from adding the names of new businesses, deleting the names of those who have discontinued, as well as accounting for changes in ownership, trade names, and credit ratings. Until recent years, only a small number of businesses here listed in Dun and Bradstreet.
