- 2 cup brown sugar teaspoon vanilla

- 2 eggs, well beaten 34 cup milk

Sift flour, baking powder, and salt together. Cream shortening with one cup brown sugar and vanilla until fluffy. Add peanut butter and mix thoroughly. Beat
