room. The theatre room itself is 40 by 36 and is heated. Just recently Mr. Henn widened the theatre screen.

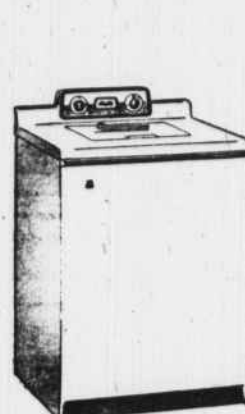
Revival To Begin Sunday At Tesenta
