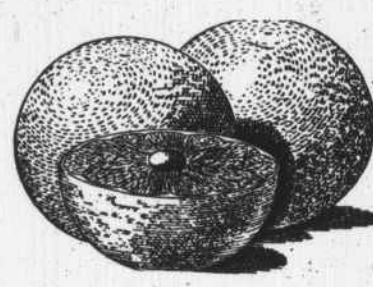

The COOKING CORNER Favorite Recipes Of MACON WOMEN

BAKED LEMON PUDDING
 1/2 cup sugar
 5 tablespoons flour
 1/4 teaspoon baking powder
 1/2 teaspoon salt
 2 eggs, separated
 1 1/2 teaspoon lemon rind
 3 tablespoons lemon juice
 1 1/2 tablespoons melted butter
 1 cup milk

Sift 1/2 cup sugar with flour, baking powder, and salt. Beat egg yolks. Add rind, juice, butter and milk and beat well. Stir in sifted dry ingredients and beat until smooth. Beat egg whites until stiff, add remaining sugar. Fold into first mixture. Pour into one quart greased baking dish. Put dish in pan of water. Bake at 375 degrees for 45 minutes.
