Funeral Services Held Monday At Asbury Church

Mrs. Mamie Dale Cabe died suddenly at her home in the Tesente community Sunday at 6:20 a. m. She was 70.

She was a daughter of Ras and Mrs. Flora Conley Penland, born Aug. 7, 1886, in Macon County. She was the last surviving member of the family. She married Melvin Cabe March 8, 1905, who survives.

Funeral services were held Monday at 11 a. m. at Asbury Methodist Church, of which she was a member. The Rev. Glenn Anderson and the Rev. R. L. Poindexter officiated. Burial was in the church cemetery.

Pallbearers were Hayes Buchanan, Lem. Herschel, and Norman Cabe, Grady Hopkins, and Don Garland.

Surviving in addition to the husband are two sons, Grady, of Franklin, Route 2, and Ray, of Waynesville; two grandchildren; and a number of nieces and nephews.

Dog Owners Are Warned

The fine for a dog owner who doesn't keep his pet shut up during specified hours is \$50 and Police Chief Sid Carter says he'll have to use it if folks don't start being more careful of the ordinance.

There have been a number of complaints recently about dogs running in packs and howling through the night, the chief said this week. "We don't want to take drastic steps but we'll have to if the owners don't cooperate with us," Chief Carter added.

A town ordinance specifies that no dog shall be left unattended if it is more than six months old and that it shall not be left unattended at night. Additionally, no female dog may be unattended during mating season.

Pine Seedlings Can Be Ordered

Applications for forest tree seedlings are now available at the county agent's office at the Agricultural Building in Franklin.

All trees will be sold this year. The price of white pine is \$5.25 at the nursery near Hendersonville and \$5.75 delivered.

There is no allotment or limit to the size of orders at present. Last year's orders of over 25,000 were reduced. Orders for less than 500 cannot be accepted. Payment in full must accompany the application.

The applicant agrees: 1. Seedlings shall be used only for forest plants, erosion control or windbreaks and not as ornamentals.

2. After planting seedlings shall be given reasonable protection from fire, grazing and other destructive agents.

It is suggested orders be placed early as the supply is limited.
