A. S. C. Will Premeasure Allotment Acreage Here

his allotment acreage laid off measurement" by Tilman R. Walker, chairman of the state A.S.C for him this year.

This service, which is offered committee producers of all allotment

Mr. Walker says, "Every year there are some farmers who, through inaccurate measurement on their own part or because of incorrect information on the acreage in permanent fields, plant either more or less than they are actually permitted by their allotment. In the case of overplanting, this causes the farmer unnecessary expense in the way of

unused fertilizer, unused plants

or seed, and treating of land that

cannot be used. In the case of underplanting this could cause

the farmer to lose some of his 'planting history'." This premeasurement service may be requested through the local A.S.C. county office. The office will furnish, train, and equip reporters who will do this premeasurement work. The farmer

will be required to pay only the

actual cost of the visit to his farm and the determination of acreage on his farm. When he makes ap plication at the A.S.C. County Office for this premeasurement serv ice, the farmer must deposit sufficient funds to cover the cost of work. The premeasured acreage will be accepted as the "official" measured acreage for all A.S.C. purposes provided the farmer plants the entire premeasured area and no more, and provided there was no obvious error made in the premeasurement.

A later trip will be made to the farm to determine that these requirements have been met, but in most cases, additional measure ments will not be necessary.

Walker reminded farmers that the only way they can be sure that they have planted their entire allotment and no more is to have the people who will later be responsible for determining compliance with the program lay out the area they will plant. Only a limited amount of this premeasurement work can be done in the short time available so applications should be made early. All farmers desiring premeasurement should visit the county office as soon as the announcement of availability and cost is made in the county, he concludes
