USING STEEL TAPES —

A. S. C. Measuring Of '59 Crop Acreage Under Way

Performance work in determining the 1959 acreage devoted to tobacco, wheat, and Soil Bank base crops is expected to be completed by June 30 in Macon County.

Reporters are now in the fields working. The major change in the performance season this year is using steel tapes in making all measurements. Aerial photographs also will be used in identifying

the fields to be measured. There are 228 burley tobacco farms, 35 wheat farms, and eight Soil Bank farms here. The initial measurement is free to the farmer. However, if the farmer desires a remeasurement he must deposit \$8. If he is planted in excess of his allotment he must make a deposit of \$5. All tobacco grown on the farm must be measured, including chewing tobacco, which would be charged to the burley allotment. Farmers planted in excess of their allotment will be notified just as soon as the measurements are made and the computations made. All disposition of excess acreage must be made in the presence of an A.S.C. representative. The excess must be made in a uniform shape of a square, rectangle, or triangle running parallel with the rows. The procedures and methods used in determining acreage and performance in connection with tobacco and Soil Bank is administered through the A.S.C. state and county committees. It is a uniform system, state-wide.

yon, and Gunter, of Gainesville, which is handling the abandonment proceedings, reiterated the Tallulah Falls Railway stand of many years that the line has been steadily losing money because of rising operating costs and declining freight shipments.

He said the line has "kept going" by not paying taxes and by not paying its principal stockholder, Southern Railway, rental on cars, terminal facilities, and other uses. This item alone has grown to an indebtedness of more than \$100,000, and Southern Railway has decided it can no longer ignore this, he explained.

The spokesman said Southern has decided that abandonment of the line is the only way out of the financial

crisis.
