**Burley Grower Applications Being Accepted By A.S.C.**

The Macon County A.S.C. office will accept applications for new grower burley allotments through February 15, according to Siler Slaughter, chairman of the county committee, which administers the program.

Application blanks are available at the office in the Agricultural Building.

The requirements that follow must all be met:



1. The applicant must have had at least two year's experience within the past five years growing burley either as a farm operator or tenant.
2. The operator must live on and obtain 50 per cent or more of his livelihood from the farm covered by the application.
3. The farm shall not have been a part of another farm during the past 5 years for which an old farm burley allotment was established.
4. The applicant shall not own or operate any other farm for which a 1960 allotment is established.
5. The farm shall be operated by the owner.

**Burley Figures**

The A.S.C. office has recently summarized the 1959 production data for Macon burley producers. A total of 191 farmers harvested 56.07 acres. Total pounds marketed was 104,524. The average yield per acre for the county was 1,882 pounds. Five producers in Macon County have an agreement with the North Carolina Agricultural Experiment Station. The total harvested acreage from these five farms was 1.45 and the total pounds marketed was 2,970. The total allotment acreage for burley tobacco in Macon County on 231 farms is 70.19 acres.
