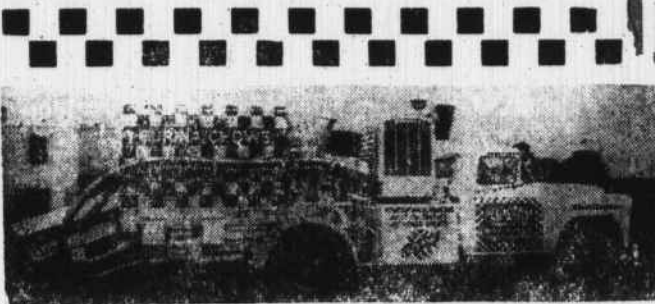


Brady's BLARNEY

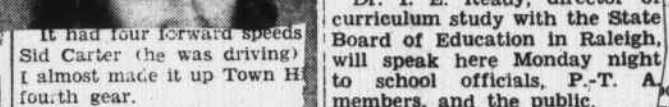

Guernsey Completes Production Tests

A registered Guernsey cow, Belmont View Traveler Lassie, owned by Belmont View Farms, of Franklin, has completed an official production record, according to the American Guernsey Cattle Club here.

This record was for 9,237 pounds of milk and 466 pounds of fat. "Lassie" was a senior two year-old and was milked two times daily for 305 days while on test.

This official production record was supervised by North Carolina State College.
