HELPFUL HINTS

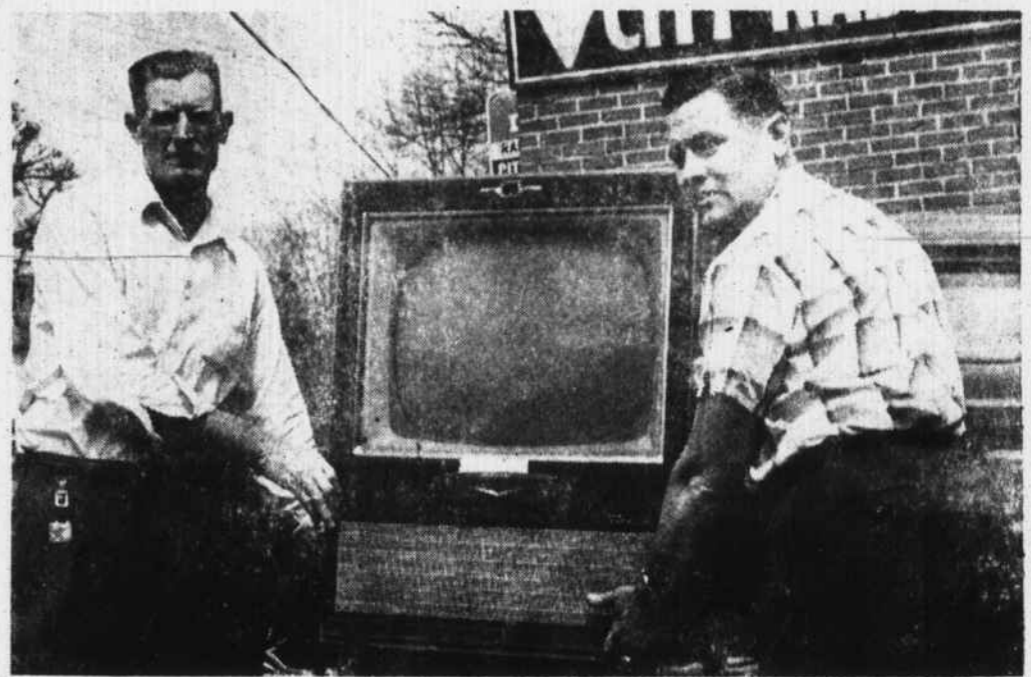
Q. Are there any herbicides for controlling crotalaria in soybeans?
A. No. The best thing to do is to avoid planting soybeans in fields known to have crotalaria. Crotalaria plants that appear anyway, should be removed by hand. If

crotalaria seed get mixed with the harvested soybeans, they could cause the soybeans to be turned down by buyers.
Q. How much is it costing North Carolina farmers to produce to hogs?
A. A recent survey of 17 producers showed that farmers are w-

ing hogs on concrete and 60 percent heavier weight to break even. The survey also showed that the cost of raising hogs on pasture was attributed mostly to the cost of raising hogs on pasture. How much land do North Carolina farmers now have in the Conservation Reserve of the Soil Conservation Service? 250,307 acres. This is an increase of 22,414 acres over 1959.
