SUMMER and WINTER EXTREMES

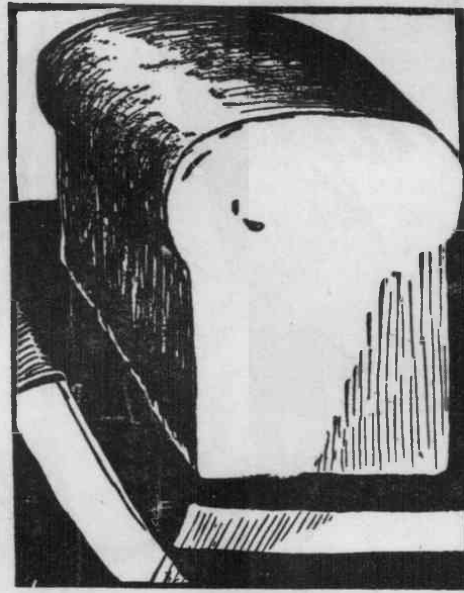
Moderated by Ice Plant and Coal Dealers—Deliver to Other Towns Nearby
