Aberdeen is the home of the J. W. Woolfolk Company of Fort Valley, Georgia, which manufactures farm and orchard chemicals and handles all manner of equipment for the farm and orchard. It has but one branch office, that in Aberdeen, where for four years it has served the peach growers and others, doing nearly \$100,000 in business here last year. Among its products sold locally are lining and cushion covers, forms and tubs for packing, crates, picking baskets, bushel baskets, containers and other orchard supplies as well as its lines of sprays and dust.
