Advertising Is Ascribed Prominent Part in Widespread Upturn in Business

To increased newspaper advertising is ascribed a prominent part "in the widespread upturn in business,' according to a survey conducted by the magazine Editor and Publisher. Virtually every section reported "improvement in the attitude of the great masses, which are more hopeful than they were a year ago and NRA is credited to contributing to the improved tone."

An Omaha publisher cited the case of one of his state's largest department stores which used 16 pages of advertising in a single day and "made the largest unit sales in its 52 years of existence." From New York, where the trend was described as definitely unward." there was said to be "an increasing success of quality offers.

Milwaukee observers were optimistic. Factories in that city were reported as employing 45 per cent more persons and paying 61 per cent more wages than a year ago. Its three largest department stores "broke all records for sales transactions on single days late in October."

New automobile sales of last 3 months tripled the volume of the same period last year, as applied to all reporting regions.

Retail stores in Des Moines, Iowa, were reported "showing large gains over last year," as were those of St. Louis and Kansas City. A leading hardware concern in the latter city showed an 80 per cent increase in sales over a year ago.
