

COUNTY BOARD AWARDS COURT HOUSE INSURANCE

The Board of County Commissioners, in regular session on Monday, ordered that the fire insurance on the court house, courthouse furniture and fixtures be awarded to Citizens Insurance Agency of Carthage in the amount of \$55,000 for one year dated July 1, 1934, and that the insurance on the jail, jail furniture and fixtures be awarded to Colin G. Spencer Insurance Agency, Inc., of Carthage in the amount of \$6,000 for one year dated July 1, 1934.

It was ordered that the current expenses of the county be disbursed pending the adoption of the official 1934-35 county budgets and that such disbursements as will be made by authority of this order be charged to the respective appropriations of the official budgets when and as such budgets are adopted.

C. C. Carpenter was granted a permit for license to sell beer at Charlie's Place on Highway No. 1, and allowance for support were made as follows: Irene Blake, Pinebluff, \$4 per month; Minnie McLean, Eagle Springs, \$5 per month. Frank Stutts of Putnam was allowed \$12 for harvesting wheat for Mrs. Blake Garner of Ritter's township.
