

Pair Held for Robbing Tobacco Farmer Here

W. J. Allen of Vass Victimized by Colored Men After Sale in Aberdeen, Alleged

John Williams and Hack Reeves, colored men of Aberdeen, were bound to Superior Court under bond of \$400, charged with robbing W. J. Allen, white man from Vass, of \$82. Minnie Ingram, alias "Minnie the Mocher," a colored woman of Aberdeen, was also bound to Superior Court under bond of \$400 on a charge of aiding and abetting in the robbery.

Allen, according to the evidence, sold tobacco at Aberdeen, after which Williams and Reeves procured for him and sold him one-half gallon of corn liquor. After getting him drunk, Allen charges, the men carried him in their car to a point about two and one-half miles from Aberdeen into a woods where they took from him his person his wallet containing \$82 and valuable papers.

Joe Thomas, white, charged with driving an automobile while intoxicated and assaulting an officer was called and failed.

Prayer for judgment was continued upon payment of the costs in the case of James G. and E. R. Teague, found guilty of trespassing upon the lands of their mother and abusing her, they are white and reside in the Hemp section.
