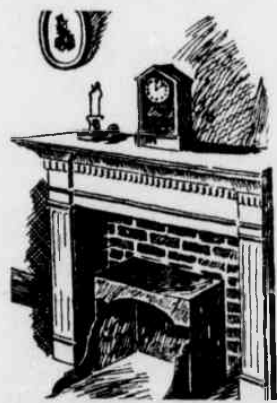

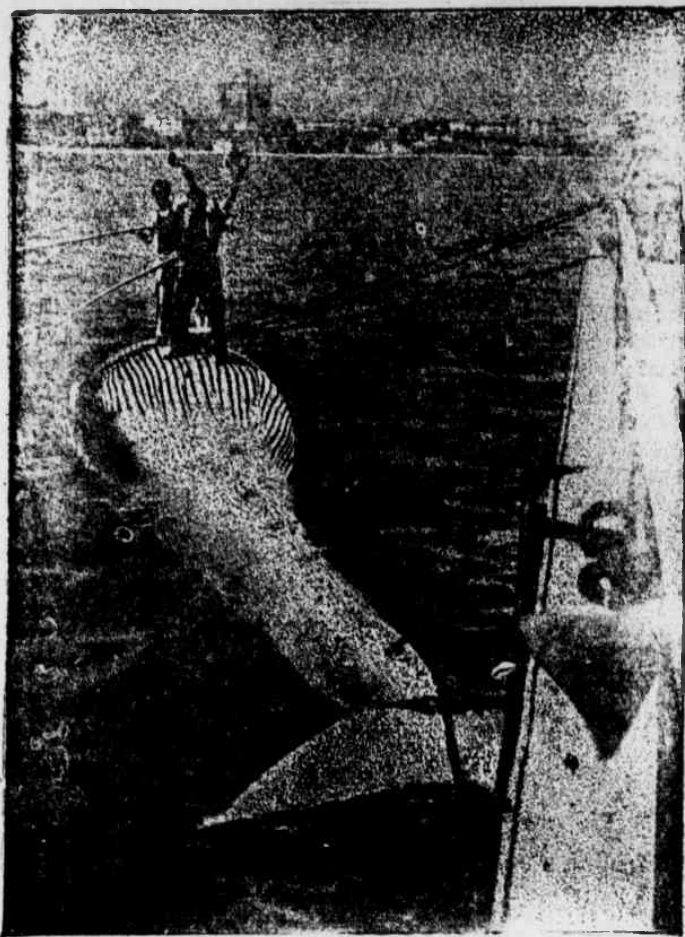


THE FRANKLIN STOVE

A Whale of a Story



"Colossus," Weighing Only 68-Tons, Will Be Guest of Southern Pines Next Wednesday on Mammoth Railroad Car

While the cavernous mouth of a whale could have easily accommodated Jonah there is still another side to the story, according to the agent who is here in Southern Pines arranging to exhibit a monster 68-ton fellow.

"A whale," says the agent, "can take into their mouth up to a thousand and pounds of fish at one time, but," he added, "they must all be little ones." A whale's throat is so small it would choke on a grapefruit.

Captain David Barnett, veteran whaling commander who is in charge of the lecturers who explain this curious 55-foot monster, has shown a thousand or more audience that it is impossible for him to shove his fist into the throat of "Colossus."

So, of course, that explains all about Jonah, or does it? As an individual citizen you can take your whales or leave them, and Jonah's too. That's a matter of individual preference, allowed under the broad terms of our constitution. But take 'em or leave 'em, a whale that attains the ripe old weight of 68 tons merits considerable interest and gets it.

"Colossus" didn't get to be the star she is without a lot of trials and tribulations. About her early life little is known. Her career toward stardom began (or should we say ended) one chilly day in November over a year ago when she was lazily studying oceanic grandeur about 165 miles off the coast of California.
