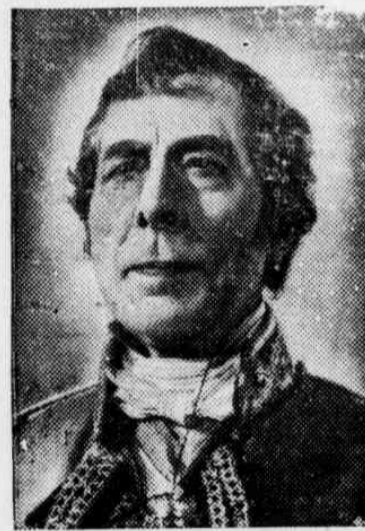

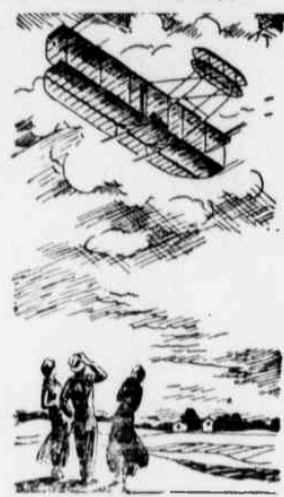
At Southern Pines
