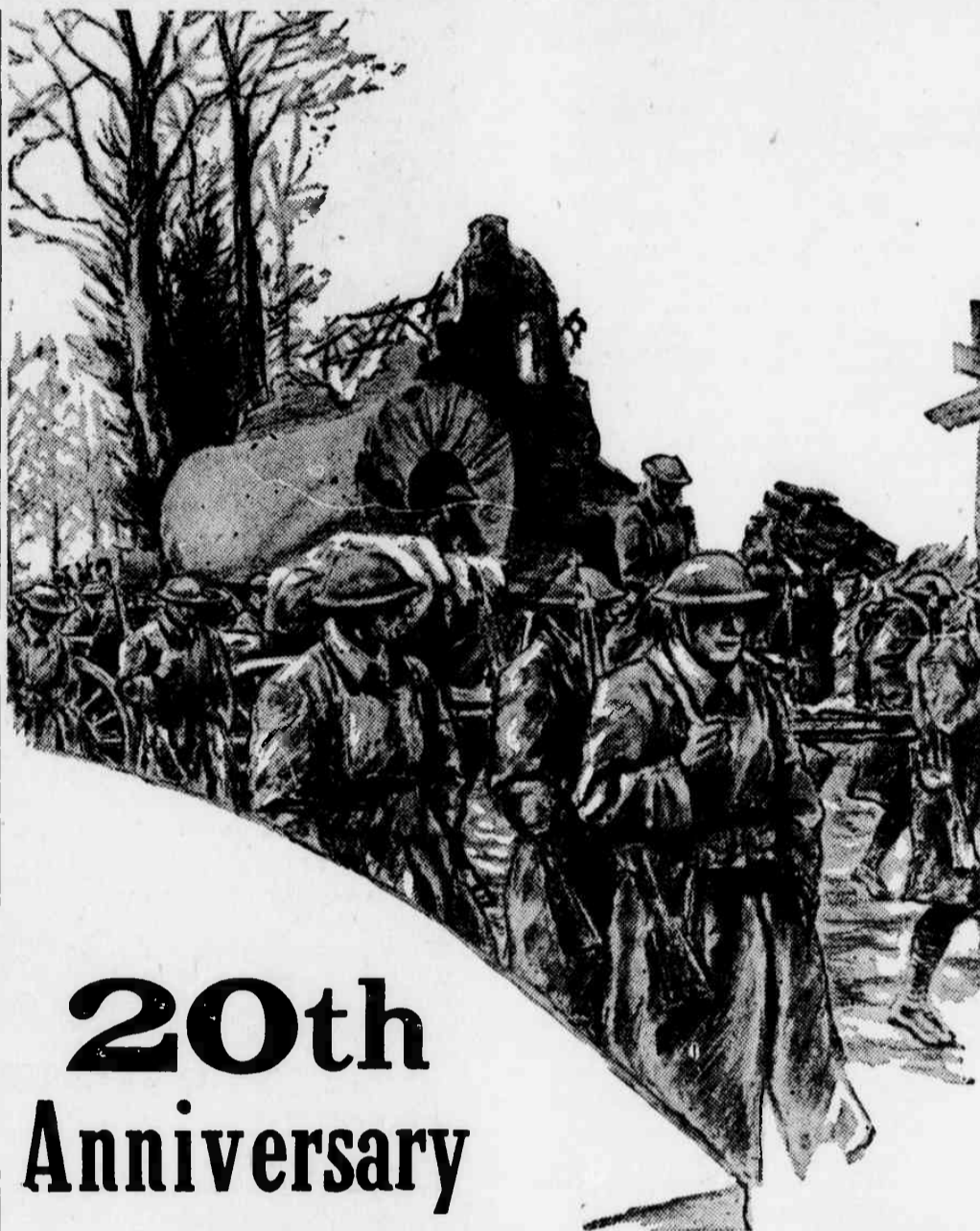

Twenty years ago American soldiers marched home from the war torn battle fields of France. Peace echoed around the world. For twenty years we have enjoyed peace in America. And it is the hope and prayer of every veteran as well as every citizen that Wonderful Peace may continue undisturbed.

These soldiers came home, however, conscious of a duty to perform, not only to preserve the land, but those fine inherent values in our American system: To fight the ISMS which threatened the citadel of our democracy, and which are enemies, not alone of our children, but are the enemies of generations of what we hope may be free men and women, yet unborn.

They came home to uphold and defend the constitution of the United States of America: "To maintain law and order; To foster and perpetuate a one hundred percent Americanism; To preserve the memories and incidents of our association in the great world war; To inculcate a sense of individual obligation to the community, state and nation; To combat the autocracy of both the classes and the masses; To make right the master of might; To promote peace and good will on earth; To safeguard and transmit to posterity the principles of Justice, Freedom and Democracy; To concentrate and sanctify our comradeship by our devotion to mutual helpfulness."

Today, sober thinking men and women in America believe that our country can be kept from involvement in other people's strife, and that Christian America will yet keep the peace and by example will afford the other nations of the earth the hope that through Democracy and Democratic institutions, the world may soon reach the goal of peace.

As the soldiers marched home, there were cheers—shouting—tears of joy—Loved ones were reunited: But pity those mothers who watched the parade and whose sons were left in Flanders Field. Perhaps it seems only yesterday to most of us, but how tortuous, and how long these twenty years must seem to those crippled, shell-shocked maimed martyrs who are awaiting the final summons when taps will bring relief to them.

Let us on this first National Legal Holiday for Armistice day, remember that great HONOR ROLL and the part they played in the world war. Let this be a day of Dedication and Remembrance to those who made the supreme sacrifice.
