

Seaboard Has Best October Since 1930

Railroad's Net Operating Revenue for Month \$103,941 Ahead of October, 1937

The net operating income for October of 1938 of the Seaboard Railway amounted to \$191,159, an increase of \$103,941 over October of 1937 and with one exception was higher than the net railway operating income for any October since 1930.

Total operating revenues for the month of October, 1938 amounted to \$3,378,802, an increase of \$19,012 or 57 percent over October 1937, and were higher than the same month of any year since 1930. Freight revenue amounted to \$2,760,018, an increase of \$89,724 or 3.36 over the same month last year, and was higher than freight revenues for October of any year since 1930. Passenger revenue for October, 1938 was \$248,806 as compared with \$325,502 for October, 1937, a decrease of \$76,696 or 23.56 percent.
