Railroad's Net Operating Revenue for Month \$103,941 Ahead of October, 1937

The net operating income for Oc_ tober of 1938 of the Seaboard Rail_ way amounted to \$191,159, an in_ 1937 and with one exception was higher than the net railway operat. ing income for any October since 1930.






