**Theatre**

In Pinehurst  
 Probably no picture has been made in some time that has aroused so much controversy, pro and con, than John Steinbeck's "Grapes of Wrath" the attraction at Pinehurst Sunday night, March 17th and Monday, March 18th, at 3:00 and 8:30 p. m. Critics, columnists and conversationalists have managed to let the public know quite a lot about this book, during the long time it has been a best seller. Writers on both side of the fence have called it daring, significant and controversial. The film is an extremely literal and very nearly complete transcription of the Steinbeck work.

This is the novel many said could not be filmed. It has been, and adults will not find it lacking in the lusty substance of the novel, but will find it relieved of offensive colloquialism. Stark, green, unvarnished dramatic characteristics makes "Grapes of Wrath" a picture of absorbing interest.

With Joan Bennett and George Raft sharing honors and a strong supporting cast, Walter Wanger's "The House Across The Bay," is the attraction at Pinehurst Wednesday, March 20th at 3:00 and 8:30 p. m. The production is based on an original story by Myles Connolly, and the central figure in the picture is Brenda Bently, played by Miss Bennett, a young girl confronted with the problem of adjusting her life to a strange fate when her husband is sent to prison for income tax evasion.

"Florian," the attraction at Pinehurst Friday, March 22nd, is the story of a very famous horse, none other than the prize horse of Emperor Franz Josef of Austria. Based on Felix Salten's novel, the story highlights Imperial Austria in its opulent days prior to 1914 and the subsequent collapse of the Empire after the first World War.
