### Sanford Man Loses Life at High Falis

49-Foot Embankment and Plunges Into River

Austin McCormick, 55, prominent ntizen of Sanford and well known throughout Moore county, was killed at 12:25 p. m. Mo 'ay at High Falls in upper Moore cu .ty, when the sedan in which he is driving alone left a 49-foot embs ment and plunged about 68 feet ross Deep River, tenally resting on its right side near the bank on the opposite side.

Mr. McCormick, a cotton buyer and eotton warehouseman, had left Sanford in the morning on a business trip side. to High Falls Manufacturing Company. When a half-mile from the mill his car left the road and went down the embankment, which had no guard rails. At that point the river is not over waist-deep and when persons near the scene forced open the door of the car, only a small amount of water was in it.


