STATE COLLEGE RELEASE

A State College extension instructional program of 18 technical courses designed to train men and women for vital positions in war industries was announced today by Edward W. Ruggles, director of Engineering Science and Management War Training at the College.

The courses, arranged "to meet the shortage of engineers, scientists, and production supervisors with specialized training in fields essential to war production", will begin January 17, 1944.

The Federal Government pays the full cost of all courses approved in the program. The only costs to students are for room, board, and textbooks. The total estimated expense per student for a twelve-weeks course is from \$80 to \$120.
