MOTHER STILL HOPEFUL

(Continued from Page 1) esting letter, from which we reprint excerpts:

"I'll try and tell you exactly what happened the day 'Mac' and crew went down. He was flying as lead navigator in a formation of B-24s that made an attack on Rangoon, Burma. The ship was hit while over the target, but stayed in sight of the formation for about five or ten minutes after they left the target. When the other men in the formation last saw the plane, it was about 5,000 feet below the rest of the formation and two men bailed out. This would place 'Mac's' plane about 15,000 feet above the ground. As far as I know, no one saw the plane crash, and there is a chance that more of the men bailed out at a lower altitude, or the pilot might have made a forced landing. The gunners who could see the ship below them were so busy trying to beat off the attacking fighters that they lost sight of it after the first two men bailed out. No one can say for certain what happened to the ship and the rest of the crew.

"Mac" and Lt. Robertson were in the nose and they had a better chance of bailing out than any of the other members of the crew. I don't want to raise false hope for you, but I always thought they were the first two men to bail out. "As near as I could figure the plane went down about 40 miles due west of Rangoon, Burma. "If they reached the ground safely there is a good chance that they will remain uncaptured. The Japs only have a few troops in this section and some of the natives are friendly. If they got in with the friendly natives they may be hiding in the hills or trying to make their way back to our lines.

"All the men were equipped with a pistol, knife, matches, medicine, fishing equipment, canteen, compass, and maps. All of this is attached either to the parachute or carried on the body. All of the men had received detailed instructions on how to live off the land and to escape capture in case they were forced down, so you can see that they have a fair chance to survive if they reached the ground safe.

"Mac" was one of the best friends I had in the Squadron. The mission before he got shot down he flew with me in a night mission. He was Squadron Navigator, and I considered him the best in the outfit. 'Mac' was also one of the best liked officers in the Squadron, among the enlisted men as well as the officers." Lt. MacPherson is the grandson of Mrs. MacPherson of Cameron and the late Hugh P. MacPherson, some of Moore County's best known citizens. Mr. MacPherson was for years a member of the County Board of Commissioners. His mother, before marriage, was Miss Orene Pierce of Cameron.

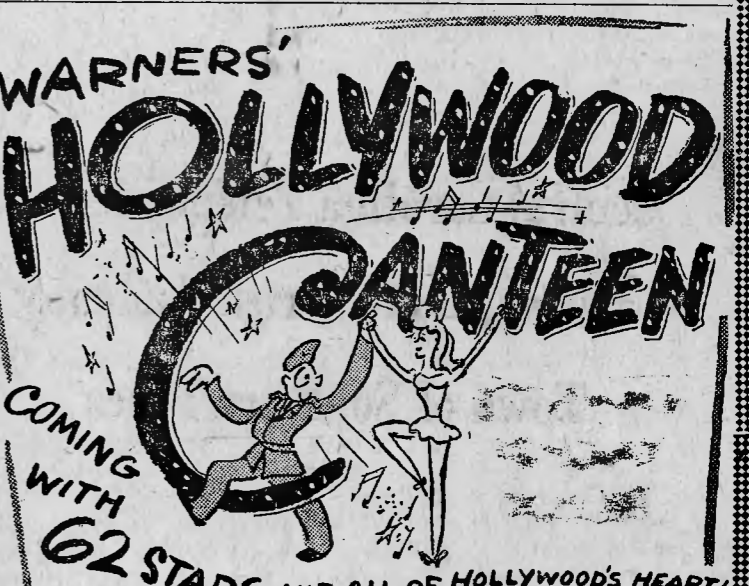
