As in other years, AAA comsons having claims against the mitteemen will consult with every estate of the deceased to exhibit farmer as to the plan for his farm and list the practices which he wishes to carry out for 1946. In approving plans, county committeemen will give consideration to the needs of all farms in the county in line with the amount of conservation money allocated to the county.

In Moore County, there is urgent need for more lime, phosphate, and winter cover crops. The 1946 AAA program is being planned to emphasize practices to supply these needs. One particular feature available this year provides a payment of \$3.50 per acre for the harvesting of seed.

According to statements Chairman Caddell, the sum of \$54,471.00 has been allocated to assist Moore county farmers to carry out practices advocated under the 1946 ACP program. Approximately \$50,000.00 has been expended to assist the farmers of Moore county in following the 1945 program.
