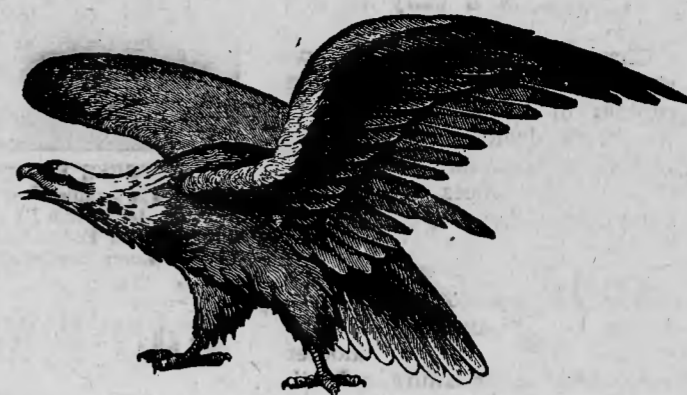


A recent treasury dispatch says:
