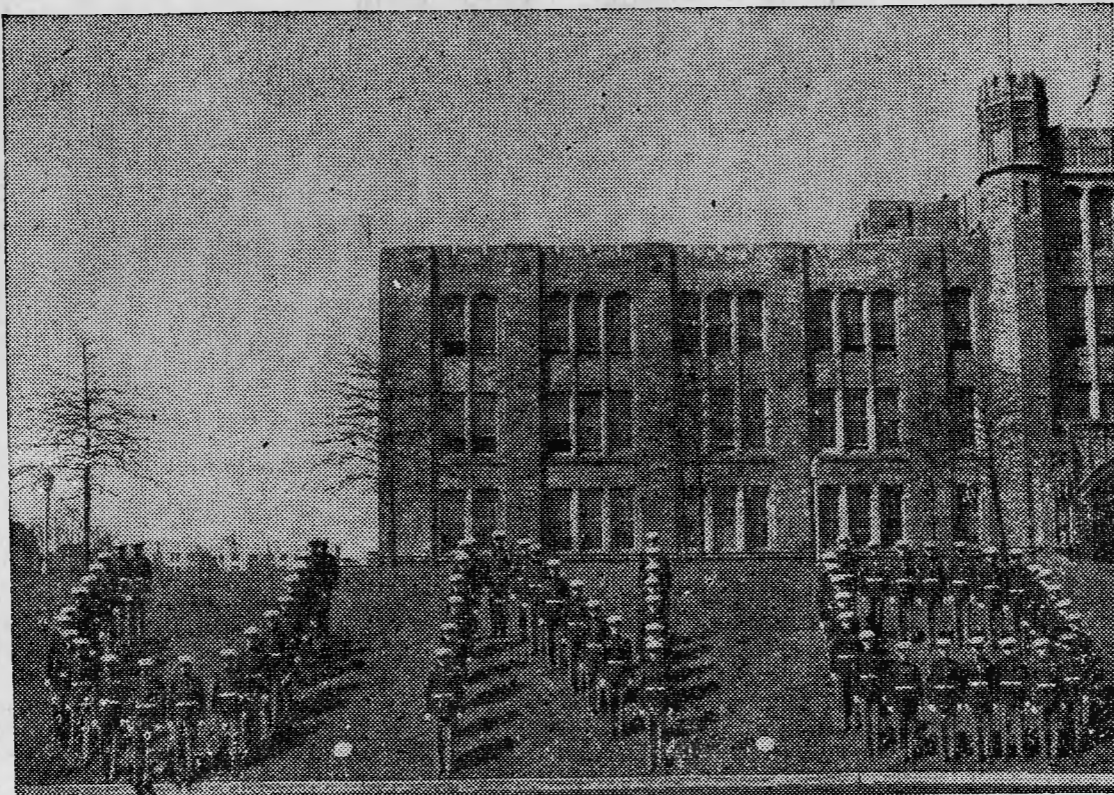

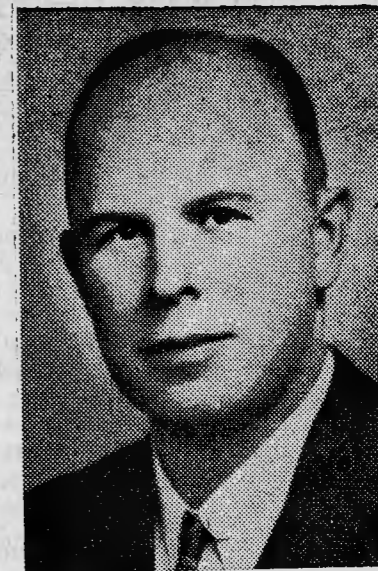
He follows her, finds she has fled to South America, and grimly goes after her, convinced that she is covering up for her guilty husband.

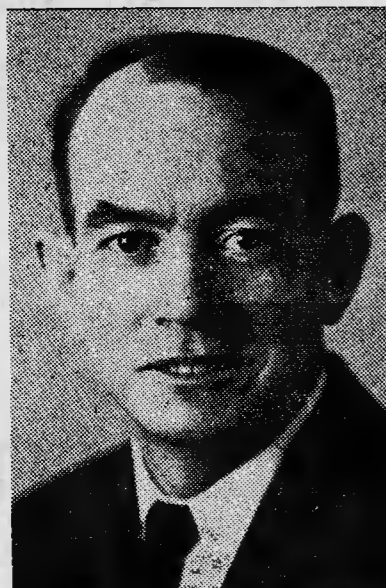
He represented Union County in the 1935 General Assembly. In 1941 and again in 1943 he was elected Senator from the 19th District.
