"Brockwell towers" are fireproof stairways, masonry-enclos ed with steel doors, affording safe exits in case of fire. Their cost is approximately \$5,000 each One is being incorporated in the end of each wing of the Robbins school on recommendation of Sherwood Brockwell, state fire commissioner, following a recent inspection.

"Brockwell towers," a nickname given by schoolmen to these stairs of the fire commissioner's design, must now by law be in-cluded in every school building more than one story high. The Robbins school was built before the law was passed.






