

WEAVING PLANT

(Continued from Page 1) order at Rockingham Monday morning enjoining Van B. Sharpe, owner of the Carthage Weaving company, his agents and attorneys, from interfering with the auction in any way. Bids were received in two ways—first, on the plant and equipment separately, then on everything together. Several bids were offered but Levy's comprehensive bid was far and away the highest. Interest had been shown for some time by several would-be buyers, and some substantial bidders were on hand. Mr. Levy heard about the sale only the day before from a friend, Leroy Lee of Carthage, and came down to look into the matter personally and place his bid. He said that present difficulties in securing material make planning hazardous, but that if the situation lightens up he hopes to put the Carthage plant into production within a few months with between 200 and 300 employees, locally hired, with only a few key men imported from Greensboro. The Greensboro plant is the only one now owned by the corporation, which in New York City, where its sales office is located, has the name of Greensboro Manufacturing Co., Inc. The plant has about 330 employees and, said Mr. Levy, "our employer-employee relationships are known as the best in the trade." The production is sold to chain stores and such volume outlets as the Sears Roebuck company. All-new equipment will be required, as the heavy-duty machinery used by the Carthage plant on duck and other thick ma-

terials will not serve for the sewing of cotton flannels and crepes. The plant, with floor space of 80,000 square feet in two large connecting buildings, contains 55 sewing machines, 41 looms, a complete finishing plant and other equipment. The receiver said the purchase price will practically assure the payment of secured creditors at 100 cents on the dollar, or nearly so. It will not, however, take care of the general creditors—they are just out of luck. The secured creditors are mostly governmental agencies to which taxes are owed.
