Practically all Negro schools in the county showed a definite loss or barely appreciable gain. West Southern Pines, the Negro school in the Southern Pines district, gained four, while the white school gained 43, enough to secure an extra teacher.

Overall figure for the Southern Pines district showed a jump from 935 last year to 982 this year. Total number of white pupils in October of this year was 552—126 in the high school, 426 in the elementary department. Last year these figures were 509 total—121 high school, 388 elementary.

At West Southern Pines enrollment reached 430, as compared with 426 last year. The high school lost four, numbering 111, while the elementary department gained eight, totaling 319.

At Pinehurst, high school enrollment (white and Negro) stayed the same, 187, while the elementary jumped from 471 to 493.

In figures compiled for the white schools of the Moore County system, four districts showed gains while five showed losses. The Aberdeen white schools were the fastest-growing, jumping from 634 to 655. a gain of 21. Highfalls gained 20, from 278 to
