## C. L. White Is Geigy Co.'s New Regional Manager

Geigy formulates dusts and liquids for cotton and tobacco pests as well as products for virtually every other crop grown in the Southeast.

"Self-employment earnings are reported on a special section of an individual's Federal income tax return, and is due by March 15, 1952. A self-employed person does not report his income on the quarterly social security tax return for his employees, but on a special return at the end of the year.

"The tax rate is 2 1-4 per cent of the net earnings up to \$3600. The tax will be between \$9 and \$81 depending on the individual's net earnings from self-employment. Payment is compulsory," Mr. Proctor concluded.

Only those who have \$400 net earnings or more for the taxable year from self-employment need to file this return. Certain professions are not covered.
