Virgil C. Willard, Vass Farmer, Passes Tuesday

Virgil C. Willard, 43, of Vass died Tuesday night at a Durham hospital after a week's illness.

Funeral services were held Thursday at 3 p. m. at Vass Presbyterian church, conducted by the pastor, the Rev. C. K. Taffe, with burial following in Johnson Grove cemetery.

Mr. Willard was born September 24, 1908, in Guilford county, the son of Eugene and Daisy Payne Willard. He moved in 1940 from Forsyth county to Moore, where he was actively engaged in farming until the time of his death.

Surviving are his wife, the former Pearl Williams; three daughters, Peggy, Reba and Joyce Ann, and two sons, V. C., Jr., and Randall, all of the home; his parents, Mr. and Mrs. Eugene Willard, of Kernersville, and four brothers, Veral, of High Point, and Jacob, Earle and Clay of Kernersville.
