**Charles V. Miller Dies At Aberdeen**

Charles Vernon Miller, 70, who had served with the Norfolk and Southern railroad for 55 years, died Tuesday morning at his home on East Main street in Aberdeen.

Graveside services were held yesterday afternoon in Old Bethesda Cemetery, Aberdeen, with the Rev. T. J. Whitehead of the Page Memorial church officiating.

Mr. Miller, the oldest man with the Norfolk and Southern and the one with highest seniority, came to the Sandhills in 1918 as an engineer with that railroad. He was born in Randolph county July 21, 1882, son of the late Benjamin Miller and Lou Jones Miller. He had served with the railroad until 18 months ago, when he went onto inactive status.

He is survived by his wife, Mrs. Margaret Martin Miller, of the home, and three daughters, Margaret Miller of the home; Mrs. Sidney W. Toman of San Juan, Puerto Rico; and Mrs. John T. Craven, of Mt. Vernon, Iowa.
